Day 0: September 8th – Depart from USA

Tonight, you will board your transatlantic flight to Ireland.

Day 1: September 9th – Welcome to Dublin

Day 2: September 10th – Journey North to Belfast

Day 3: September 11th – Belfast and Titanic Experience

Today delivers a deep dive into Belfast's past and present. A local **hop-on guide** will bring the city's stories to life, revealing how history has shaped modern Belfast. Visit the world-renowned **Titanic Experience**, an immersive attraction built on the very site where the ship was constructed. After, we'll head to **The Deer's Head Brewery** to try their delicious pints. This evening, enjoy the **first performance of the trip with The New Barleycorn**, featuring local drinks, a traditional gig, and dinner at a local venue - a perfect blend of culture, music, and Belfast hospitality.

Day 4: September 12th – The Giants Causeway



After breakfast, you will embark on a journey north to visit the iconic **Giant's Causeway**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in County Antrim, formed by volcanic activity 60 million years ago. Steeped in Irish mythology, it is said to be the handiwork of giant Finn McCool, who built it as a pathway to Scotland.

When you return to Belfast, you will have the late afternoon and evening free to explore at your own pace - browse local shops, sightsee, enjoy a leisurely walk, or unwind in a traditional pub. This balance of guided experience and free time lets you make the most of your last day in Belfast (*we will provide local, authentic restaurant recommendations in advance so you can plan your “free nights” with ease*).

Overnight: Ten Square – Dinner on own

Day 5: September 13th – Derry and Donegal

Depart Belfast and head west to the historic city of **Derry** for a **guided walking tour** of its famous walls and streets steeped in history. Discover local craftsmanship and a tasting experience at the **Walled City Brewery**, where you will learn, relax, and lunch together over local brews!



From here, continue into the rugged landscapes of **Donegal**, where wild coastlines and strong local traditions await. The evening concludes with a group hotel dinner, providing a warm welcome to this distinctive and scenic region.

Day 6: September 14th – Sliabh Liag



Today showcases the raw beauty and creative spirit of Donegal. Visit the dramatic cliffs of **Sliabh Liag**, among Europe's highest sea cliffs, offering breathtaking views of the Atlantic. Afterwards, there will be a chance to discover local craftsmanship at **Triona Design** and sample **artisanal whiskey at a nearby distillery**. Return to the hotel in the afternoon and get ready for the **2nd performance of the trip**. The evening brings everyone together for live music in a local venue, which will be followed by a group dinner - an unforgettable night of food, friends, Irish music, and true Donegal atmosphere.

Overnight: Waterfront Dungloe – Dinner and Gig at a Local Venue

Day 7: September 15th – Travel along the Atlantic to Athlone

Leave Donegal behind and journey inland, stopping for a memorable **Atlantic Sheepdogs demonstration** that highlights rural Irish life and working farm traditions. Continue to **White Hag Brewing** for a tasting that celebrates bold, modern Irish craft beer. Arrive in Athlone, a lively town on the River Shannon, where the evening concludes with a relaxed group dinner at the hotel. This day blends countryside heritage with Ireland's contemporary brewing culture.



Overnight: Hodson Bay – Hotel Dinner with group

Day 8: September 16th – Farm and Farewell Gig



Your final full day celebrates the best of Irish brewing, culture, and community. Visit **Ballykilcavan Brewery and Farm** to see estate-grown barley and sustainable brewing practices in the heart of Ireland, followed by a tasting of their delicious beers. The journey concludes with a farewell meal and **final performance** at a local venue - a fitting end to an unforgettable Irish adventure.

Overnight: Hodson Bay – Dinner and Gig at a Local Venue

Day 9: September 17th – Back to USA
