Select routes introduce fresh touches, such as Palamós on Spain’s Costa

Island Dreams: Hawaiian Cruises with NCL

On the inter island voyage, you'll visit four islands in a week, often with precious overnight stays on Maui and Kaua'i so you can linger: catch sunrise over Haleakalā, sample farm fresh cuisine in Upcountry, or steal a quiet morning on Hanalei Bay before most visitors arrive. Hilo and Kona deliver Big Island contrasts—lush waterfalls and volcanic landscapes on one side, coffee country and clear

snorkeling coves on the other—while O'ahu blends urban energy with iconic beaches and WWII history. NCL's shore experiences in Hawai'i lean into authenticity, from cultural workshops and local music to guided hikes among endemic flora. And because the ship is your effortless basecamp, you unpack once and let the islands come to you, day after day. Longer itineraries pair Hawai'i with dreamlike French Polynesian lagoons or even Alaska's rugged coastline, turning your trip into a dual chapter adventure of reefs and glaciers. On board, Hawaiian inspired menus, live music, and open air evenings keep the Aloha spirit flowing between ports, while spacious decks invite you to simply watch the sea shift colors until the stars appear. If you've always wanted Hawai'i to feel both epic and easy, NCL's 2026 program is your invitation to experience more—with time to breathe it all in.





Discover The Last Frontier: Alaska Adventures With NCL

Alaska isn't just a place—it's a feeling of awe you carry long after you've returned home. NCL's 2026 season is crafted to immerse you in that wonder, with four dedicated ships sailing itineraries from April through October. Choose seven-day roundtrips from Seattle for classic Inside Passage magic or opt for open-jaw routes between Vancouver and Whittier that add extra time in glacier country. On board Norwegian Bliss and Norwegian Encore, all-day scenic cruising through Glacier Bay transforms the ship into your moving observation deck, enhanced by expert commentary and viewing tips. Norwegian Joy and Norwegian Jade round out the program with port-rich itineraries that average long days ashore—think ten hours to truly savor Juneau's whale-watching, Skagway's vintage rail journey, Sitka's nature trail hikes, and Ketchikan's totem

heritage. Some sailings also highlight Dawes or Hubbard Glacier, offering spellbinding moments of blue-ice drama and echoing calving sounds you'll never forget. NCL's approach is designed for explorers: flexible shore options span helicopter landings on the Mendenhall Glacier, kayak safaris, salmon bakes in forest clearings, and photography tours tuned to peak wildlife hours. If you're dreaming bigger, special 16 day itineraries stitch together Hawai'i and Alaska for one epic voyage—snorkel volcanic shores in the islands, then chase eagles and icebergs up the Pacific coast, all without repacking. Back on board, panoramic lounges, heated outdoor spaces, and hearty, Alaska-inspired menus make the ship feel like a cozy lodge with a front-row seat to the wild.
