THE VISION

Viking was founded in 1997 with an unwavering belief: that the most meaningful travel happens not when you simply visit a place, but when you truly connect with its people, culture and stories. For us, this means going into the heart of each destination we visit.

Our journey began on the world's iconic rivers, offering immersive itineraries to discerning guests along such waterways as the Rhine, Danube and Seine. As demand grew, so did our reach—from the Douro to the Nile and onwards to the Mekong—each river voyage guided by our core principle that our ships should never upstage the destination but rather connect you more closely to it.

In 2012, we introduced our innovative Viking Longships. Built specifically to navigate Europe's waterways, they elevated river voyages to a new level of sophistication and comfort, blending understated elegance with thoughtful Scandinavian design. Their patented three-deck layout maximizes space, allowing for generous and light-filled public areas, full-size verandas, true two-room suites and fully alfresco dining. Nimble in size, with a distinctive square bow, their agility enables them to dock in the very center of riverside cities and villages—bringing you closer, as only a river voyage can.

By holding to our vision, we led the remarkable growth of modern river travel and continue to remain at the forefront. Now, with over 28 years of experience designing river voyages, we control or have priority access to 110 of the world's most coveted docking locations.

Along the way, we have been honored with consistent top ratings and accolades from both travelers and industry experts—recognition that has made Viking the world's most award-winning river line.

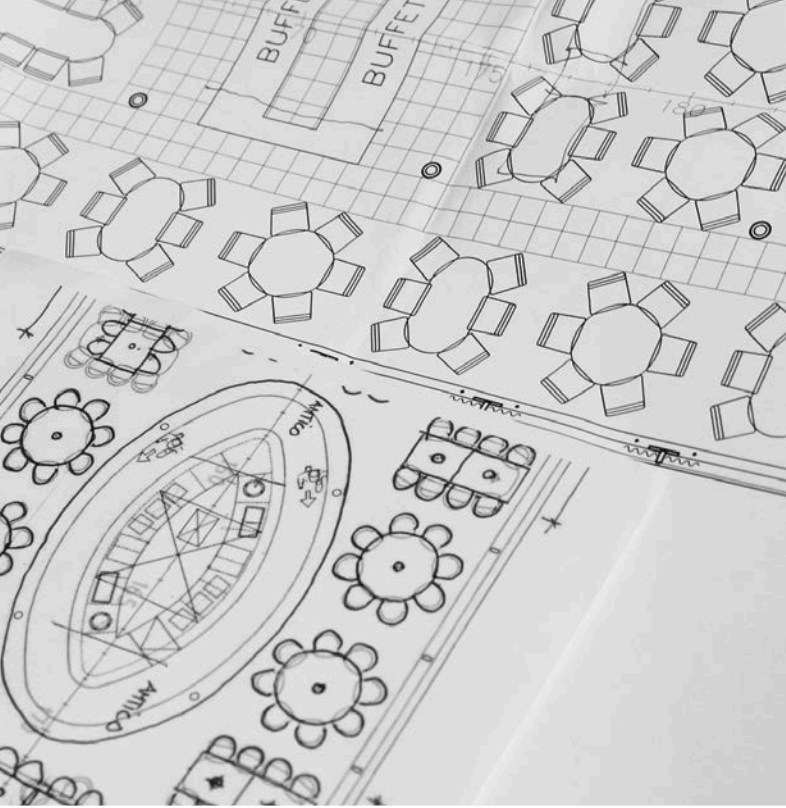
Inspired by this recognition, as well as requests from our loyal guests, we carried our signature destination-focused philosophy to the seas, with the launch of our ocean voyages in 2015. That same year, we were rated #1 for Oceans by *Travel + Leisure*—an honor we have received consistently in the years since.

To create the distinctive Viking experience at sea, we reimagined the concept of an ocean ship from the inside out. Nearly identical in layout, so you feel equally at home on each, our elegant sister ships celebrate our Nordic heritage with clean lines, richly woven textiles and light woods that embody the Viking spirit of discovery and deep connection to the natural world.

With a veranda in every stateroom, bringing the world's beauty close enough to almost touch, and an atmosphere of serene sophistication enriched by opportunities to learn, your journey becomes an extension of the destination itself.

In 2022, we celebrated our 25th anniversary with the launch of our expedition voyages, introducing new journeys to Antarctica, the Arctic and the Great Lakes. Later that year, the debut of the *Viking Mississippi* ushered in a new era of modern river voyages to America's heartland.

Now exploring all seven continents, Viking is a global leader in experiential travel. We have more than 450 awards to our name, including being rated #1 for Rivers and #1 for Oceans five years in a row by *Condé Nast Traveler* in the 2025 Readers' Choice Awards. This distinction only strengthens our resolve to continue creating destination-focused experiences for curious travelers.

A legacy of exploration with remarkable ships

The spirit of exploration runs deep in our name. Over 1,000 years ago, during the great Viking Age, Norse seafarers charted unknown waters—navigating Europe’s rivers and braving the Atlantic Ocean on ingenious ships with indefatigable resolve. They forged trade routes east and ventured west across uncertain seas, reaching as far as Iceland, Greenland and even North America—centuries before other Europeans would set foot there.

Wedded to the water, the Vikings were master shipbuilders. Their pioneering vessels had powerful hulls, built to ply the oceans but also to be agile. Designed for both speed and endurance, these ships were recognized, respected and emulated across the known world.

At Viking, we cherish our connection to these seafaring pioneers. Their curious spirit inspires everything we do—from the innovative ships we build to the thoughtful journeys we create for our guests.

BUILDING ON OUR RICH HISTORY

Honoring the past, shaping the future

Our vision is built on more than the questing spirit of the original Viking explorers. We honor their ingenuity, craftsmanship and deep connection to nature. That same philosophy continues to shape our river, ocean and expedition fleet today. Each ship embodies a blend of heritage design and modern innovation, full of thoughtful touches to enrich your journey and enhance your comfort.

Like the original Viking ships, our vessels are crafted with clean, purposeful lines for agility and endurance—able to traverse great waters while slipping easily into small ports. You will find echoes of Nordic tradition in every detail: handcrafted woodwork whose imperfections reveal its pure character; accents of

slate, teak and limestone that exude authenticity and evoke the natural world; rugs and tapestries woven with intricate patterns and rich colors that evoke the earliest artists and craftsmen from Norway to Iceland.

Many of our itineraries, too, follow in the wake of journeys once taken by the Vikings, driven by their insatiable curiosity—through the Baltic and along Norway’s stunning coast, across the North Sea to the British Isles, the Faroe Islands and beyond; westward to Iceland, Greenland and even North America. Others reach deep into the Mediterranean, where sails of Viking ships once marked the shores of southern Europe and North Africa.

RESPONSIBLE TRAVEL

Viking is committed to delivering a superior travel experience to our guests, and also to operate responsibly wherever our journeys take us. The communities we visit are at the core of the travel experience, and we seek to work with local individuals and companies, creating long-lasting mutually beneficial partnerships.

In addition to Viking's direct contributions, our guests' discretionary spending fuels local economies. Spending more time in port than traditional cruise lines, providing an included shore excursion in each port, and encouraging rather than deterring guests from bringing local food and drink on the ship increases the economic impact our port calls have.

Perhaps nothing exemplifies our approach better than the wall art that adorns many of our ships' staterooms: instead of meaningless corporate art, we pair photographs of iconic global sights and destinations with drawings made by grade school children. This initiative, a joint effort with two rural Viking-sponsored schools in China has been expanded to include drawings from schoolchildren in Egypt and from communities along the Mississippi River.

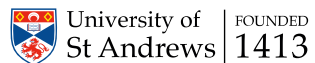
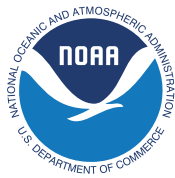

Our expedition ships are designed as working research vessels, each is equipped with a well-appointed Science Lab that has been developed in partnership with the University of Cambridge and Niva and designed to support a broad range of research activities. Guests have supervised access to The Science Lab to learn from and participate in meaningful research alongside working scientists. In addition to our ongoing partnership with Cambridge University, Viking has also endowed a new Chair of Polar Marine Geoscience at the Scott Polar Institute.





TECHNOLOGY & THE ENVIRONMENT

At Viking, we are conscious of our responsibility to the environment and the regions through which we sail; thus, our ships are designed to the highest environmental standards.

Our vessels, though dependent on shoreside infrastructure and supplies, operate as self-sustained entities, capable of providing electricity, water and waste treatment facilities. The careful management to minimize our environmental footprint is essential and all our vessels are designed to be environmentally responsible and efficient to operate. While each vessel class has specific operational characteristics, some key principles can be found across our entire fleet:

EFFICIENT USE OF SPACE—Because every bit of added weight results in extra fuel consumption, we are careful to add to our ships only what is needed, prioritizing optimal guest comfort and operational efficiency.

SLEEK HULL DESIGN—Our ocean and expedition vessels have been designed with energy-efficient hulls, propellers and rudders to reduce resistance in the water and therefore reduce fuel consumption.

DIESEL-ELECTRIC PROPULSION—Virtually all our ships use diesel/electric propulsion technology, where a series of electric motors drives the ship propellers, while the diesel engines act as a generator. Diesel-electric technology is also future-proof: with time, it will be easy to replace diesel engines with more sustainable technologies, such as batteries and fuel cells.

SHORE POWER—The vast majority of our vessels can connect with shore power to reduce, where possible, reliance on fuel while in port. This allows operations with zero emissions and less noise. Our own docking facilities along Europe’s rivers are being equipped with rapid charging systems to further reduce reliance on diesel fuel.

ADVANCED RECYCLING & WASTE MANAGEMENT—Our entire fleet is equipped with advanced wastewater treatment systems, ballast water treatment systems (ocean & expedition) and onboard trash compacting and recycling centers to minimize the generation of waste and enable responsible recycling in shore facilities.

ADDITIONAL FEATURES—Across our fleet, other measures in place to reduce our environmental footprint include: low-energy LED lighting resulting in a lower heat output, lower power usage and a longer life; waste heat recovery systems that use the heat from the engines as a free source for heating water; intelligent HVAC systems that reduce power when rooms are not in use; and noise & light pollution reduction technologies, reducing our impact on local communities and landscapes.

The above-mentioned technologies, in combination with vessel-specific characteristics, allow us to deploy a fleet of very efficient vessels that meet or exceed environmental regulations across the world.

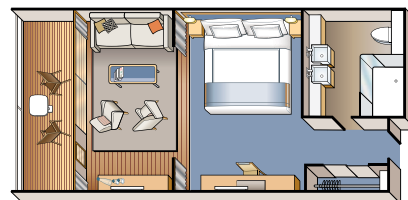

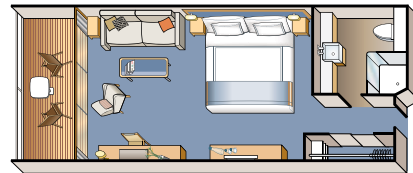

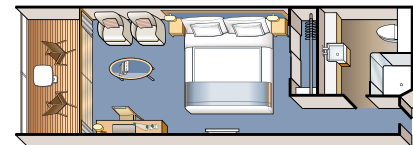

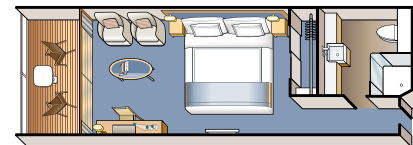

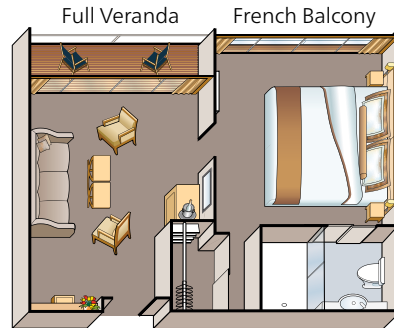

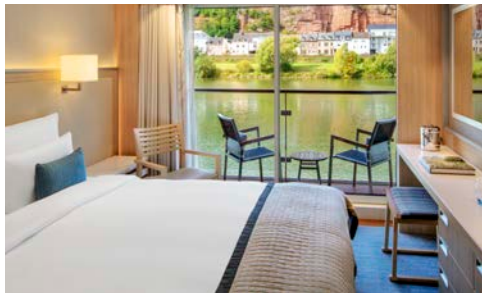

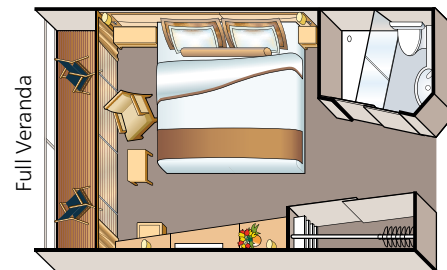


Veranda Stateroom (A, B) | Stateroom size: 205 sq ft

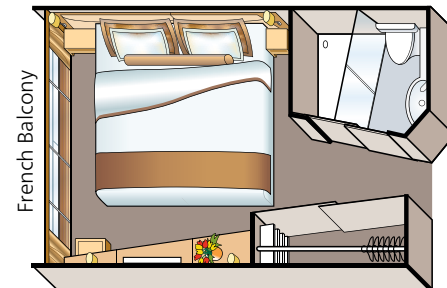


French Balcony (C, D) | Stateroom size: 135 sq ft

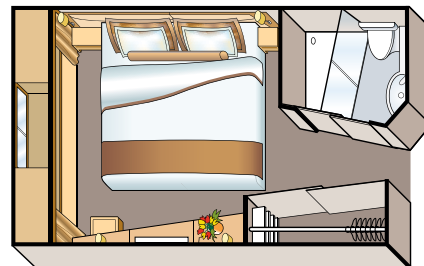

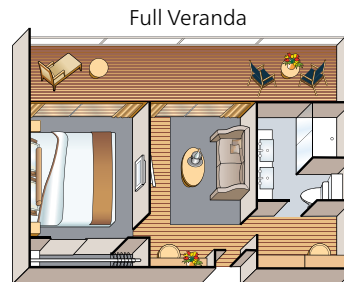

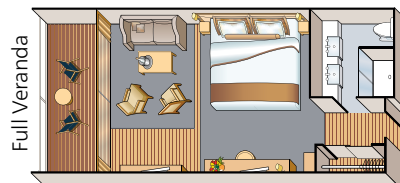

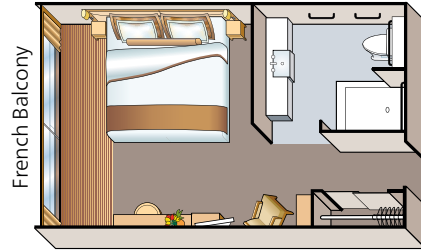

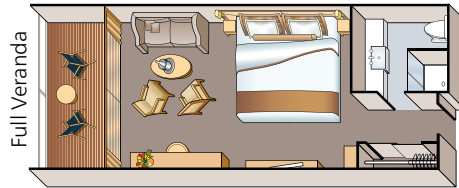


Penthouse Veranda (PV) | Stateroom size: 336 sq ft

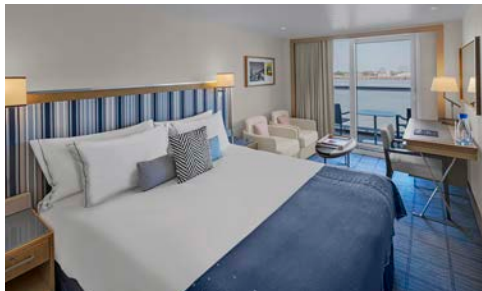

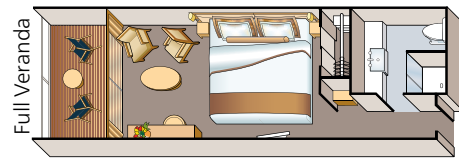


Veranda (V) & Deluxe Veranda (DV) | Stateroom size: 268 sq ft
